Friends of Scouting is an annual direct-solicitation campaign, reaching out to Scout families, service organizations and businesses. The campaign is made up of two divisions: Executive Board and District. The District Division is further divided into two campaigns: Community and Family.

Friends of Scouting accounts for over 18% of the council's income. Additionally, the United Way recognizes the value of Scouting and provides 10 percent of the council's annual budget.

It costs over \$120 to provide one year of quality program for each Scout.

What does a Friends of Scouting Membership provide?

- Local programs and activities throughout the council territory
- Camp scholarships, uniforms and registration fees for at-risk youths
- Scout service center that coordinate Scouting activities and provide customer service to members
- Accident and liability insurance to protect both youth and adult members
- Professional staff who counsel, guide and inspire volunteer leadership
- Camps and facilities available for year-round camping and Cub Scout family outdoor events
- Opportunities to attend summer camp and high-adventure events
- Advancement programs where Scouts are recognized for learning and making progress on goals they set and attain
- Literature and training-material development and distribution
- Leadership training for young people who will become future community leaders.
