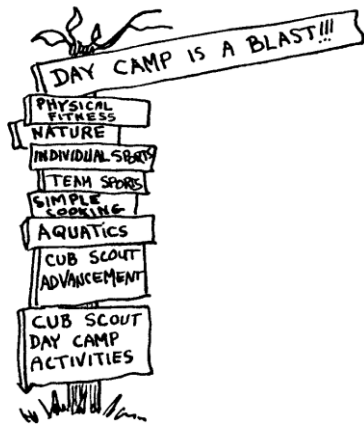

Camp Information

T-shirts: Each day camper will receive two custom-designed T-shirts! Parents at Fun with Son Weekends will also receive a shirt!

Camp Day: Day Camp is a full day of fun activities starting at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 4:00 p.m.

Again for 2010:

Day Camp Den Pictures: Your son will be given a den photo to capture the memories of his camp experience.

Day Camp Patch: Each day camper will receive a custom-designed day camp patch.



Camperships: Camperships are available for families with a financial need. Applications for assistance need the recommendation of the Cubmaster for consideration. Forms may be obtained from the Scout Service Center.

Refund Policy:

All refund requests must be in writing and received prior to the start of camp. Refunds will be issued as follows:

Before May 21, 2010: full fee minus \$25 non-refundable program fee.

After May 21, 2010: full fee minus \$40 non-refundable program fee.

Refunds will be issued in the month of September.



CAMP ACCREDITATION: Burlington County Council camp sessions are certified by the Boy Scouts of America and the State of New Jersey Dept. of Health. Safety is our primary concern. Our camp sessions are maintained at a very high standard and are supervised by trained staff.

Dear Parents,

By now, Cub Scouting has provided many exciting activities and experiences for you and your family, and yet the fun and excitement of Scouting is just beginning. As the program year winds down in your pack, you can begin to plan for the summer. The 2010 summer Outdoor Camping program offers opportunities that boys will want to participate in with their buddies. Activities tailored to meet their needs await them all at the Burlington County Council Cub Scout Day Camps and the ever popular Fun with Son Weekends.

Awaiting all Cub Scouts and Webelos are adventures that will excite them, provide them with a host of lifetime memories, lasting friends, and Scouting skills that will help them move up the ladder of Scouting. New Tigers are also eligible to attend with their adult partners.


You may rest assured that during your son's stay at camp he will be in good hands. In addition to his unit leaders, the camps are directed and operated by experienced Scout leaders, graduates of Boy Scouts of America National Camp Schools, trained aquatics experts, certified health officers, specialists in all phases of scout craft programs, and a physician on call at all times. We appreciate the efforts of all these dedicated volunteers.

We are encouraging packs and dens to attend Day Camp as a group while providing leadership for the boys. We would love to have you come for a day to walk with your son's den as they go through the camp program. If you are able to volunteer for the full week of camp, you will have two options. As a staff volunteer you can come as a Den Guide and receive a refund of \$40.00, mailed at the end of your five day week. Your other option is to apply to be on Camp Staff. As a Camp Staff member you will be a Program Area Specialist and receive a \$200.00 stipend for your six day week. This option requires at least a 2-week commitment and more pre-camp involvement including getting the areas ready for the boys and attending training. There is a Tot-Lot available for non-scout children of the Day Camp volunteers at a fee of \$15.00 per child, if registered during early pack registration.



In order to reserve your son's spot for Day Camp, simply fill out the enclosed application, including the medical form on the back, and turn it in to your Pack Day Camp Coordinator. In order to qualify for the discounted camp fee of \$150.00, parent volunteers must be provided. The deadline for Early Pack Registration is April 9, 2010. See registration form for details. Individual applications will be processed starting April 16th at a fee of \$250.00. Space in each camp week is limited, so register early. The available spots go quickly and are on a first-come, first-served basis.

The Camp Administration is looking forward to providing a fun-filled experience for your son and you!
