

Volunteer Cub Camp Job Descriptions

Den Guides: Cub Scouts are placed into “camp dens” by age/rank. Den Guides (adult volunteers from the Packs attending camp) lead these dens from area to area, helping in each area as the boys participate in theme related activities. The Den Guides also supervise the den during lunch and den time. In accordance with BSA guidelines, each den at camp must have 2-deep leadership.

Program Area: Volunteers will assist the Program Area Specialists conduct the program as planned by the Program Director. These adult volunteers will stay in each area to receive the “camp dens”. They join their sons for lunch.

Theme Area: This area may include games, crafts, painting, storytelling or other theme related activities as developed by the Program Director

Craft Area: This area may include sawing, hammering, painting, gluing various projects as developed by the Program Director.

Science/Nature: This area may include hikes, tree/leaf identification, simple science experiments, fishing, or other nature activities as developed by the Program Director.

Sports Area: This area may include setting up and carrying out organized competitive and non-competitive sport activities, as developed by the Program Director, such as kickball, volleyball and/or activities involving water to keep the boys cooled down.

Scout Skills Area: This area may include outdoor cooking, simple first aid, teaching simple knots, pocket knife safety/whittling, fishing, the bouldering wall or other theme related activities as developed by the Program Director.

Den Chief: Helpers over the age of 11 and under the age of 14 with a parent/guardian present at camp. They will be assigned by the Camp Administration to assist with a den and/or an area as needed.

Food Preparation: this applies only to the Fun with Son Weekends. This adult is responsible to prepare a pre-planned menu with the food supplies provided.

Health Officer: This person must be at least 21 years of age and hold current Red Cross/American Heart Association First Aid and Professional-level CPR/AED Certification.
