To help you be better prepared to deliver the Promise -- your Scouts deserve it.

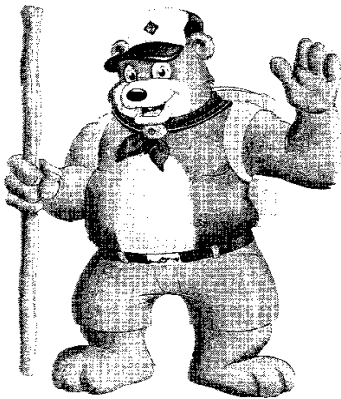
